



Town and Country Kiddies
Forest Schools Trip to the "Classroom in the Woods"
bases at Ashby Cum Fenby

As part of our outdoor EYFS Curriculum, we are once again organising a Forest Schools trip on Wednesday 12th July 2017 to "The Classroom in the Woods" and on this occasion the Literacy Theme for the day will be the popular children's book "The Gruffalo".



Parents can find more information on The Classroom in the Woods on Facebook. This is an extra-curricular trip so additional payment is required.

To book your child a place please call 01507 606000 and leave your booking, quoting your child's name and FOREST SCHOOLS TRIP. There are 14 places on the trip only due the higher level of staffing ratios required.



Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis, and as these trips are normally very popular, we recommend that you book your place without delay. We will call you to confirm your place, please leave your phone number in your message, so we can reach you easily.

The children will depart from James Street Nursery by 9am on the 12/07/17 and can be collected from James Street at 3pm (from the garden). For security reasons please do not try to collect your child from the coach.

A packed lunch needs to be provided by yourself for your child on the day. Water is of course provided throughout the day and there will be two light snacks given.

The cost of the trip will be £20.00 (this is extra to any childcare fees that are payable if your child usually attends on this day). Please note that the Nursery does not make any profit on this trip; the price covers the cost of the minibus hire, insurance, extra staffing ratios required for trips offsite and day entrance charges levied by the venue itself. Forest School trips do run twice a year and the days are alternated to ensure fair access to all families. Once your place has been confirmed you will need to pay the £20.00 in advance of the day, in cash. A briefing paper will then be issued to confirm your place on the trip and provide you with more information about the day itself. If payment is not received in advance then your place will be offered to any child on the waiting list.

Please note that the day is being led by an Ex Head Teacher Mr. Richard Dawson who has over 40 years' experience teaching children and he will be supported by our own preschool staff. There will also be a qualified first aider at the venue as well as within our own staff team.

We hope your child will enjoy the day!
